**Real nappies are made of cloth and can be used over and over again. They reduce the amount of waste sent for disposal and also the amount of energy and non-renewable resources used to produce disposables.**

## Changing style

There's not a safety pin in sight with Real Nappies, so they're simple to use. They come in lots of modern and funky styles that fasten easily with poppers, velcro or nifty little plastic grips so the nappy fits your baby snugly.

Real nappies can be easily washed at home or nappy laundering services are available.

## Save money

The Women's Environmental Network has calculated that buying and washing your own nappies can save you over £600 for your first baby compared to the cost of disposables.

Savings could be even greater with a second or third child.

If you buy your own re-usable nappies or join a nappy laundering scheme your local authority, in partnership with Hertfordshire County Council will reimburse you up to £40.
